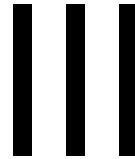

Key Nature Foundation SA Programs are as follows:



bushbankSA Our Bushbank program involves the purchase of remnant vegetation, protecting it with a Heritage Agreement and a special Nature Foundation conservation management plan and then on-selling it to sympathetic new buyers willing to abide by the terms of these agreements. The 10,000 hectare Blanchetown Bushland Estate is the largest example of the Bushbank program.

NATURE GAINS

Through corporate sponsorship, the Foundation is becoming involved in major habitat restoration programs in the Northern Flinders Ranges, Yorke Peninsular, Murraylands and elsewhere.

RESEARCH

Our research grant program helps budding environmental scientists undertake a wide range of important on-ground research to help determine future conservation priorities for South Australia.



Through the Water for Nature program, the Foundation delivers water to wetlands along the River Murray. We don't claim that we can save the Coorong but we have already made important contributions to Little Duck Lagoon and Hogwash Bend, both important wildlife habitats in the Riverland region.

The Nature Foundation has programs in place to help each of the following threatened species. Your help will not only boost each of these programs but allow us to add more threatened birds, animals and plants to our list of active projects.



Red-tailed Black-Cockatoo – the sub-species of this magnificent cockatoo that lives in South Australia's South East and in western Victoria is now at risk with less than 1,000 surviving. The Nature Foundation is planting thousands of bulokes (one of their key food sources) at Frances and protecting a number of existing stands of mature bulokes on private property.



The Black-flanked Rock-Wallaby or Warru – South Australia's most endangered mammal (with only 100 animals in the wild in the Musgrave Ranges) is being helped through the support that the Nature Foundation is giving to the Warru captive breeding program at Monarto Zoo.



The Striated Grasswren - one of a number of ground-dwelling birds in the Arid Lands that is struggling to survive in the face of drought, feral cats, foxes and loss of habitat. The Nature Foundation is providing vital research funds to projects that aim to identify the best ways to protect these tiny birds.



Peppermint Box - the Nature Foundation's Bushbank program identifies remnant bush blocks that have important ecological significance such as areas with the rare Peppermint Box trees pictured here. We buy such properties, protect them with a Heritage Agreement and tailored management plan and re-sell them to sympathetic new owners.



Frogs - frogs in the natural environment have been likened to the coalminer's canary in the cage. If they start disappearing then we know that the surrounding habitat is in trouble from a biodiversity viewpoint. Nature Foundation funds are therefore being applied to a range of habitat recovery programs that aim to 'bring back the frogs' to our local streams and creeks.



The Regent Parrot – this threatened species now has only one major nesting site on the River Murray at a place called Hogwash Bend near Waikerie. Through the Nature Foundation's Water for Nature program, we have been able to provide desperately needed water to help keep the remaining redgums alive in this important area.
