The Process

The process for Nature Foundation to consider a gift of land is:

- After a landowner enquires about making a Gift of Land, Nature Foundation staff undertake a desktop assessment of the land
- If the assessment meets Nature Foundation requirements, a meeting is scheduled with the landowner
- With the landowner's consent, staff undertake an in-person assessment of the land and information is gathered from the landowner
- Staff provide a recommendation to the Nature Foundation Board
- The outcome of the Board's decision is shared with the landowner
- If both parties are happy to proceed with the Gift of Land, an Agreement is prepared and signed by the landowner and Nature Foundation.
